Offering 435m2 of habitation over three floors, the property combines family comfort, historical elegance, and a wide range of layout possibilities as a primary residence, guesthouse, tourist venture, or professional project.

Upon entering the Manor House a beautiful chestnut staircase and high ceilings immerse you in the warm atmosphere of a home full of character. The ground floor includes three elegant reception rooms, a spacious kitchen opening onto a south-facing terrace, a laundry room, a shower room, a separate toilet, and a wine cellar.

On the first and second floors, you'll find 9 bedrooms, several bathrooms, a library with a fireplace, a walk-in closet, offices and areas for play and relaxation. Three of the bedrooms open onto a charming south-facing gallery balcony, typical of the local architectural style. The convertible attic space offers exceptional volume and the possibility to create additional rooms to suit your needs.

At the rear of the house, a rare landscaped park in the town center holds delightful surprises: a palm grove, rows of bamboo, a bicentennial plane tree, a stream, a well, picnic areas, and even direct access to the Le Saleys river. A true haven of peace. A set of 8 enclosed garages completes this exceptional property.

As expected of a property in this location, the Manor House is connected to mains gas and mains drainage and renovations to

the roof elevations have been carried out between 1998 and 2015. However, some remodeling of the floor plan should be anticipated, particularly over the first and second floors, to suit modern day requirements.

Just a few minutes' walk from the thermal baths, shops, restaurants, cafés, cinema, medical services, and public transport, this property enjoys a prime location. Salies-de-Béarn, known as the "Salt City" and a renowned spa town, lies between the Atlantic coast (Biarritz) and the Pyrenees ski resorts, with close access to TGV train stations, highways, and Spain.

This is a rare, historic property with high potential. Whether for a family, tourist, or professional project, this manor house offers a unique lifestyle in one of the most charming villages in the South-West of France.
